Permit hearing and consideration of, including action on, permit applications: Mr. Rick Crabtree seeks, under application ADW-20180309-01 and AOW-20180309-02 a drilling permit and a production permit nonexempt uses authorizing the production of 80.65 acre-feet per year of groundwater for industrial uses. The well is located on a 15,074.391-acre tract of land located near the intersection of FM 1593 and FM 426 in Jackson County, TX.
4. Consideration of and possible action on matters related to Groundwater Protection including complaints, investigations, violations and enforcement related to disposal and injection wells, contamination and waste, and permitting.
