

**Texana Groundwater Conservation District
Notice of Public Meeting and Permit Hearing**

Notice is hereby given in accordance with the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Government Code and Section 36.404 of the Texas Water Code, that the Texana Groundwater Conservation District will hold a public meeting on July 18, 2024, at 6:00 PM at 411 N. Wells St., Edna, Texas 77957. During the meeting, the Board of Directors is scheduled to conduct a permit hearing, consider, and possibly take action regarding the following permitting request(s):

Mr. Christopher Hajovsky seeks, under permitting request case PRC-20231012-01, a waiver of the rules of the district and an amendment to production permit VPW-20161215-01 associated with grandfathered well GW-00348 to authorize the production of groundwater permitted under historic use validation permit VPW-20161215-01 (1,007.51 acre-feet per year) from grandfathered well GW-00348 and non-grandfathered well NW-00751. The subject wells are located on a 398-acre tract of land near the intersection of FM 1157 and County Rd. 206 in Jackson County, Texas.

Any person who intends to contest a permitting request must provide written notice of that intent to the District at P.O. Box 1098, Texas 77957 at least three calendar days prior to the hearing date in this public notice. If the District does not receive a timely notice of intent to contest a permitting request, the Board of Directors may cancel the related permit hearing and take action on the permit request(s) at the next regular board meeting in accordance with the Rules of the District.
